Dr. Eric Paulson

Dr. Eric J. Paulson is a Professor in the Department of Curriculum and Instruction and director of the Doctoral Program in Developmental Education. His teaching background and interests include postsecondary literacy instruction in developmental education domains, including community colleges and 4-year colleges, and he has taught in a variety of institutions in several countries and states. His research interests focus around college transitional readers' deliberate and non-deliberate responses to texts and conceptualizations of literacy, utilizing approaches applied within a social-constructivist framework that include eye movement research, miscue analysis, and metaphor analysis

Amy Getz is the Manager of Community College Services at the Charles A. Dana Center at the University of Texas at Austin. Her work focuses on the reform of developmental and gateway mathematics programs at community colleges and four-year institutions through working with state and regional systems and implementation of the New Mathways Project. Amy led the development of the Quantway™ curriculum in partnership with the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching.
